Timothy Peters is the Dean of the School of Business and Professional Studies. In this role he is responsible for the following academic programs: Undergraduate Business, MBA, Masters in International Studies (MAIS), Nursing and the Adult Degree Completion program. Dr. Peters led the development of the CU Accelerate program in 2000, and the MAIS degree that grew from the university's work in China. The other programs were added to the school under the umbrella of business and adult instruction.

His work with China began when he developed a special teacher training program for teachers in Shenzhen China. These teachers spent 3 months at Concordia learning about Western teaching theory. The MAIS program was developed from this initial program with China. He has traveled in China several times in the development of this program.

Prior to his present role, he was a professor in the School of Education and managed the student teaching program. Prior to his joining Concordia in 1994 he served as a Lutheran Elementary school principal in various locations. His wife, Dr. Becky Peters is a professor in the School of Education.
