Open to all Concordia students, alumni, faculty and staff. Deadline for Submissions: February 8, 2013

Guidelines for Literary Submissions:

1. Length limits (per piece submitted): 1200 words for short fiction, creative nonfiction and drama; 40 lines for poetry.
2. Submit no more than five poems and/or two prose pieces.
3. All submissions must have a title.
4. Thoroughly proofread your work.
5. Submissions that are accepted for inclusion in *The Aerie* may be edited for length and technical accuracy.

How to Submit:

To facilitate a blind reading process for literary submissions, each submission must have a cover sheet that lists the author's name, title of the work, genre (fiction, nonfiction, etc.) and contact information. The author's name should not appear on the piece itself. Entries must be received by **Friday, February 8, 5:00 p.m.**

Entries should be emailed with attachment to Kristen.schmidt@cui.edu. Current Concordia students should use their eagle email account. The subject line should read *Aerie Submission*. The email should include the author's name, title of creative piece(s), genre and contact information, and the attached document must be a .doc or .docx file. The file name should be the author's last name. More than one poem or story may be attached to the same email.

All submitted pieces will be reviewed during spring semester. You will be notified if your work is accepted for the spring publication of *The Aerie*.
