ASCUI Elections 2012 Rules and Guidelines for Elections

You are encouraged to campaign in the following ways so long as they have been approved by the ASCUI Advisor Monica Lum and ASCUI Communications Director Margaret Foreman:

- Have 2 large posters (not to exceed 4'x6')
 - See poster guidelines for approved posting areas or contact the ASCUI Communications Director for further questions
- 20 flyers total (from mail room) size 8"x11" or 11"x17"
 - See poster guidelines for approved posting areas or contact the ASCUI Communications Director for further questions
- Facebook groups/pages are okay so long as you do not mention any other candidate(s) and keep the groups/page clean and professional
- One power-point slide for the monitors in the Grimm Student Union and Grimm Hall.
 - Please make your slide using PowerPoint and e-mail your slide as an attachment to the ASCUI Communications Director Margaret Foreman at <u>Margaret.Foreman@eagles.cui.edu</u>
- Mailbox stuffers (no larger than a 3"x5" index card)
- Table tent flyers to go into the clear triangular-cases in the cafeteria
- Handouts
- T-shirts so long as they are clean and appropriate
- Door to door campaigning (as long as you are not posting items on doors and are respectful of students)

You are **NOT** allowed to:

- Deface other candidates at **ANY TIME**
- Put handouts or flyers on cars or residents' doors
- Write on the walkways or windows
- Group campaigning is not allowed (ex. Jack for Treasurer and Jill for Secretary)
- *****No campaigning within 50 feet of the voting sites*****
 - ***** You may **NOT** have **ANY** posters or flyers up within **50 feet** of the voting sites on the day of the voting*****
 - ***** You may NOT verbally campaign within 50 feet of the voting sites on the day of voting*****
 - *****If you are asking friends to wear t-shirts for you they are NOT allowed to linger within 50 feet of the voting sites on the day of voting*****

To send items to the copy room e-mail <u>copy@cui.edu</u> or go to the mail room and attach your document to an order form. *Make sure for both of these options you state that it is for CSLD purposes. ***** ALL POSTERS AND FLYERS MUST BE APPROVED AND STAMPED by the ASCUI Advisor and ASCUI Communications Director BEFORE being posted****

Candidates will be allowed to campaign from February 6th to February 9th. Elections will be held on February 10th during the following times and locations:

- 7-9:30am in the Grimm Hall Breezeway
- 11am-12pm at Emendare
- 12-2:30pm in front of the Student Union

Voting will be tabulated after voting closes and the results will then be released the following Monday February 13th.

• *****Ballots will be held in the CSLD for at least 7 days per ASCUI Constitution, Bylaw 512.
