Please note that our academic year runs summer, fall and spring. You will only be awarded for the academic year listed.

No awards will be made until you have been accepted for admission and have a complete financial aid file. The priority deadline for new students is 30 days prior to the beginning of the first term. Returning students' priority deadline is 30 days prior to the beginning of the academic year.
