No student reporting sexual harassment or sexual assault will be subjected to University disciplinary action for concurrent violations of policy.  Critical to a proper response to sexual assault victim is sensitivity to the victim's need to control the process as much as possible. How you respond to a report of a sexual assault is dependent upon the following circumstances: When and where did the assault happen? Is there an immediate medical need? Is the perpetrator an imminent threat? Are others in danger? Is the student willing to report the assault to the authorities? Do you have a conflict of interest that may hinder your ability to be objective? This sheet cannot completely address all possible situations related to sexual assault. Each victim will respond differently based on their history and circumstances of the assault.
