

2017-2018 Application for Graduation Information Undergraduate Students

Graduates may choose to walk in either the Fall Commencement Ceremony or the Spring Commencement Ceremony. Please check the website more information. Graduates may only participate in one commencement ceremony within the same academic year of their Application for Graduation. Students who do not complete their degree requirements within the academic year for which they applied will be required to submit a Reapply Graduation Application. Re-applicants are not eligible to participate in commencement.

Fall 2017 Commencement Ceremony

When: Saturday, December 16, 2017

Location: Concordia University Arena (gym)

Please Note: Seating for guests is limited. Overflow seating will be provided. Tickets may be required for guests.

- 9:00 a.m. - Arena doors open
- 9:30 a.m. - Commencement Lineup (Behind Gym)
- 9:55 a.m. - Commencement procession will begin. Faculty Marshals will assist with lineup and seating. Names will be read using cards. Students may sit with whomever they wish.
- 10:00 - 11:30 a.m. - Commencement Ceremony. All graduates are expected to remain seated until the entire ceremony has ended and faculty have recessed.

Spring 2018 Commencement Ceremony

When: Saturday, May 5, 2018

Location: Bren Events Center, UCI Campus

Students may invite as many guests as they wish.

- 12:00 p.m. - Bren Events Center doors open
- 12:30 p.m. - Commencement Lineup (Lot 6A Bren Events Center, UCI Campus)
- 12:55 p.m. - Commencement procession will begin. Faculty Marshals will assist with lineup and seating. Names will be read using cards. Students may sit with whomever they wish.
- 1:00-2:30 p.m. - Commencement Ceremony. All graduates are expected to remain seated until the entire ceremony has ended and faculty has recessed.

APPLICATION FEE

The following application fee covers the administrative time needed to process the application, run a degree audit, track the student's progress and post the degree to the student's transcript. It also covers the cost of ordering and mailing the diploma. This fee is required even if you are not participating in a commencement ceremony.

HONORS

Undergraduate students will receive honors at graduation for work completed through their previous semester; however, the student's permanent record will reflect the overall GPA through the final semester. Because ABSN students are completing their second bachelor's degree, they are not eligible for honors recognition. Latin honors are determined on the basis of the cumulative grade point average (GPA) of all coursework completed at Concordia University and all other colleges and universities attended. Students who complete the requisite number of Honors courses and/or hours will receive recognition at graduation as either Honors Associate or Honors Scholar. Students who qualify for honors will be invited to the Academic Achievement Service on Friday, December 15, 2017 by the Office of the Provost.

REGALIA - FREE

Graduates will be responsible for ordering their own regalia (cap, gown, stole and tassel). Graduates will be informed via email when to pick up regalia.

Exit Loan Counseling
