- iii. There have been changes and we are cleaning up some things
- iv. Feedback
 - 1. Erika- Meal Exchange in Eagles Landing
 - a. Not ready to talk about that yet- it is a larger conversation
 - b. Will bring to University Services
 - c. Eagles' Landing was reopened for a late night place for people and those not on meal plan
 - d. Space cannot hold for everyone on meal plan
 - e. Earliest would be further out than spring semester
 - f. Need to see volume from at least one semester
 - g. Maybe an option for café closed time
 - h. Financial and logistical piece
 - i. We need to keep the balance and be able to have people to have access to meals
 - 2. Celina- At lunch and dinner, the grill has not been open. There have been staff issues
 - a. At the beginning of the semester, it was due to the volume of food we realized we needed
 - b. Needed to readjust
 - c. I was not aware it was happening- it should not be the case and I will bring that back to the kitchen
 - 3. Ashlie- Students have experienced at later times that there is little food out and it is a bummer to not have those meal options
 - a. It has been addressed
 - b. Pizzas, and Fire and Ice bar may run out earlier
 - c. Have worked on being conscious of it
 - d. Waste is a huge problem on this campus
 - e. Why we have been changing the portion sizes- trying to eliminate waste of food
 - f. Trying to find the balance
 - g. At 7- grill, salad bar, and dessert
 - h. The decision to extend hours for athletic practices- the volume was tracked and very few people came in
 - i. Changed hours to 7:30 close
 - ii. Grill open- made to order, helps to eliminate waste
 - 4. Student- flies and bugs in cafeteria
 - a. Has been working on it
 - b. Heat surge brought in a lot of bugs, plus doors and vendors

- c. Working with exterminator and adjusted their schedule
- d. Changing out lights, spraying non-toxic sprays
- e. Looking to smog it
- 5. Nick- At Eagles' Landing- Huge line and lack of efficiency. Takes a long time to just get a drink
 - a. Have hired another person- full time cook on grill
 - b. The space is a work in progress
 - c. Have more people on staff
 - d. Watching health code to be sure it is thoroughly cooked
- 6. Student- Open caf jobs to students? Workers seem to get annoyed with student requests
 - a. In order to cook food, there needs to be a certain skill level that students do not have
 - b. There is a safety issues for certain aspects of the work
 - c. In process of hiring new cashiers- application online
 - d. On the line cooking jobs- need someone with experience
 - e. Changing how the utility team works to better rotate responsibilities
- 7. Catherine- What is the status of the fridge in eagles' Landing
 - a. Have bids out
 - b. Bid on one
 - c. Most are made to order and not in stock
 - d. Hope that it will be 2-4 weeks
 - e. Could you put food in drink fridge? commuters like the salads and sandwiches that were available
 - f. Plan to have cashier for food section on the right side?
 - i. Looking into it and when there are those need periods for that extra person and how to adjust the schedule
- 8. Evette- There are no prices for snacks posted. Can we post those?
 - a. Could get on that
- 9. Adam- People feel like their meal plans and extra meals are going to waste. Cannot swipe in people or roll over their extra meals
 - a. Never has happened on this campus
 - b. That is not a decision that Bon Apetit would make alone
 - c. Question to take to university services
 - d. Determine if that was even possible
 - e. Catherine- Could there be a meal plan with guest packages included?
- 10. Nayeli- Going to caf before class with to go box, but dropped it and couldn't double swipe
 - a. Ask for a manager at that point to better assist the students

- b. It is an honor system
- c. It is all you can eat or all you can fill up in your to-go box
- d. The system only lets you swipe one time
- 11. Erika- Is it possible to make it so if you miss a meal, that money would turn into flex?
 - a. There would need to be a change in the system and look at structural changes
 - b. Financials are not equivalent
- 12. Braden- There are spatial constraints for commuters in Eagles' Landing and no spaces to sit. Could you open it up during Wednesday chapel time
 - a. It is something that can be looked into
