### APPLICATION DEADLINE: MAY 15, 2022

#### APPLICATION

Submit a video recording that demonstrates the participant's highest level of musical achievement. The submitted selections must represent one of the following style periods: Baroque, Classical, Romantic, Impressionist, 20<sup>th</sup>/21<sup>st</sup> Century. Please upload the video to YouTube (unlisted) or other similar, easily accessible video-sharing website.

- Video audition and application due May 15, 2022.
- Results announce May 18, 2022.
- Tuition is due June 1, 2022.

All participants must prepare two contrasting repertoires to perform at the camp.
