



Concordia University Irvine offers an in-depth, affordable and online certificate for those looking to further their theology of worship education.

- Overall cost of the program is \$1500 and the learner will participate in three 7-week experiences over the course of a year, avoiding the busiest seasons of the church calendar.
- Students earn 9 continuing education units (CEUs) through three modules: (1) biblical theology of worship, (2) worship design, (3) issues of worship and culture.
- CEUs are for continuing education and as such do not bear academic credit or earn grades. This allows the program to be affordable and manageable while providing a robust and meaningful experience of learning.
