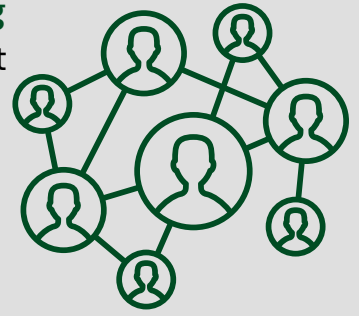


# NETWORKING BASICS

## WHY NETWORK?

- Gain insights into industries and roles
- Receive career advice and mentorship
- Access the hidden job market
- Expand your professional circle

## HOW TO PREPARE

- **Research:** Learn about the person or organization before reaching out.
- **Elevator Pitch:** Craft a brief introduction about who you are and your career interests.
- **Questions:** Prepare thoughtful questions to ask during your conversation.

Dress professionally & be punctual.  
Be genuine & show enthusiasm.  
Listen actively & take notes.  
Never directly ask for a job; focus  
on building relationships.

## STARTING THE CONVERSATION

### Sample Introduction:

"Hi, my name is [Your Name], a [Your Year] majoring in [Your Major] at Concordia University Irvine. I'm exploring careers in [Industry] and would appreciate any insights you could share."

### Sample Questions:

- How did you get started in your career?
- What does a typical day look like for you?
- What skills are essential for success in your field?
- Are there any professional associations you recommend?
