LUTHERAN WOMEN'S MISSIONARY LEAGUE SOUTH WISCONSIN DISTRICT GUIDELINES FOR THE ENDOWMENT FUND FOR UNDERGRADUATE FEMALE CHURCH WORKERS

A. WHO MAY APPLY FOR AN LWML SCHOLARSHIP IN SOUTH WISCONSIN DISTRICT?

Active female members of congregations of the South Wisconsin District of the Lutheran Church Missouri Synod who are residents of the SWD prior to college and are preparing for full-time* church work in the LC-MS are eligible to apply. You must be an undergraduate student at one of the educational institutions of the Synod during the school year in which you would receive this scholarship. (*Full-time service in the church is defined as any position available through the Board of Assignments of the Synod.)

B. HOW TO APPLY FOR AN LWML SWD SCHOLARSHIP

- Download the application form from the LWML SWD website at www.lwml-swd.org. Go to the Resources tab and select Scholarships.

- Applications must be postmarked by April 30th, 2024 to apply for funds for the 2024-2025 school year. Completed applications can be submitted:
 - o by attaching the file to an email (You may sign, scan and email your copy of page 1)_
 - by mailing a printed copy to the address above.

C. LWML SWD SCHOLARSHIP POLICIES

- 1. Financial need is considered, but is not the exclusive criteria.
- 2. **Applicants need to reapply each school year**. The amount of the scholarships will not be automatically renewed but will be re-evaluated each year and decisions will be made on current circumstances, recommendations and available funds.
- 3. Students need to submit all of the items listed on the checklist below. <u>All</u> items must be postmarked by April 30th, 2024

- 5. or the application will be disqualified. <u>Re-applying students:</u> The Professor Reference must be completed by someone who has not previously written for you. References can be mailed with the application or sent separately by the reference writer.
- 6. Recipients should understand that they are not going to remain anonymous. A photo will be requested upon notification of a scholarship award. This picture and a short write-up of each recipient will be shared on the LWML SWD website and by other possible means so that we can encourage our members to support our recipients in prayer and be in touch with them on a regular basis.
- 7. Scholarship monies will be forwarded to the student.

CHECKLIST OF ITEMS TO SUBMIT:

- 8. A recipient is expected to lead a God-pleasing life and to be faithful in their studies, maintaining at least a C *(or 2.0 on a 4.0 scale) average and serve in full-time church work a minimum of two (2) years after graduation. Students who discontinue their church work program, leave school prior to graduation or do not complete this minimum service are asked to return scholarship funding.
- 9. Notification of results will be mailed to all applicants on or before the 1st of August.
