- have a good academic record generally this means a GPA (or equivalent) of 2.75, B average or better (A lower GPA will require two additional letters of support from your University).

Upon successful application:

Students will be sent a Letter of Offer. The Offer will request acceptance in writing, and payment of tuition fees (if applicable) and Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC) – an Australian Government requirement. Once these are received, a Confirmation of Enrolment (CoE) will be issued. Students then need to provide details of the CoE to their nearest Australian Embassy/High Commission/ Consulate in order to apply for a student visa to study in Australia.
