2009 SCHOLARSHIP POLICY

Here are the new policy requirements for granting Balboa Bay Republican Women scholarships:

I. For graduating high school seniors the criteria are:

- US Citizen and a Republican; if 18 years of age, must be registered to vote
- Preferably a woman
- Must be a resident of Orange County
- Of good character
- Scholarship candidate must be planning to work toward an academic four year degree
- Scholarship recipient is encouraged to join our organization

Selections are based on academic achievement, community involvements, including employment, and a 1,000 word essay (or less) on "Why the United States Constitution is Unique in Human History." We require 2 years of official transcripts, current photograph of student, and two letters of recommendation from either a teacher, counselor, principal or clergyman along with the application and essay. Three high school scholarships are offered at \$1,000 each.

II. One \$1,000 college scholarship is offered, and the criteria are:

- US Citizen and a Republican; if 18 years of age, must be registered to vote
- Preferably a woman
- Must be a resident of Orange County
- Of good character
- Scholarship candidate must already be enrolled in college and working toward an academic four year degree
- Scholarship recipient is encouraged to join our organization.

Selections are based on academic achievement, community involvements, including employment, and a 1,000 word essay (or less) on "Why the United States Constitution is Unique in Human History." We require 2 years of official transcripts, current photograph of student, and two letters of recommendation from either a teacher, counselor, principal or clergyman along with the application and essay.

III. One "Gil Ferguson Scholarship for a Returning Woman Student" of \$1,000; the criteria are:

- Candidate must be at least 25 years of age and returning to college to complete a Bachelors or Masters Degree.

- US citizen and a resident of Orange County.
- Registered as a Republican for the most recent General Election and voted in that election.
- Preferably a woman
- Of good character
- Scholarship recipient is encouraged to become a club member

The academic requirements for adult students have been similar to that of the high school and college students. We've relaxed on the transcripts, but have required the 1,000 word essay, "Why the United States Constitution is Unique in Human History", and community involvements. Political involvement in support of Republican candidates is a plus. Please include current photograph with application.

Rules for Selection for all candidates:

- Scholarship winners will be interviewed and chosen by the scholarship committee with the input and approval of the board.
- The deadline for application is Friday, May 15, 2009. Winners are announced on June 1st.
- Winners will be invited to the June Scholarship luncheon and may bring one guest which the club will pay for. If recipients wish to bring other guests, it must be at their own expense.
- In addition, the scholarship fund may sponsor a student or two to attend the Advocacy workshop in Sacramento for high school students each year.
- Selected students will be interviewed by the scholarship committee at Woody's Diner on Thursday, May 28 from 5:00 to 6:00pm. Please bring money for a snack or beverage. The address of Woody's Diner is 3461 Via Lido, Newport Beach. The phone number 949-723-8777.
