

Anti-Hazing Transparency Reports

The Stop Campus Hazing Act requires institutions of higher education to comply with certain campus safety and security related requirements as a condition of their participation in various federal programs. A requirement of this act asks institutions of higher education to publish biannually a Campus Hazing Transparency Report which summarizes findings concerning any student organization found to be in violation of the standards of conduct relating to hazing.

There were no hazing violations found between July 1, 2025-June 30, 2026.

There were no hazing violations found between December 1, 2025-November 30, 2025.

Concordia University Irvine also complies with the Annual Hazing Incident Report Pursuant to AB 2193 (Holden, 2024), Ed. Code § 66305-66309 and reports annually to the Chairs of the California Assembly Higher Education Committee and the Senate Education Committee
